Researching carbon farming as a business model and developing a Mediterranean-tailored monitoring, reporting, and verification (MRV) framework.



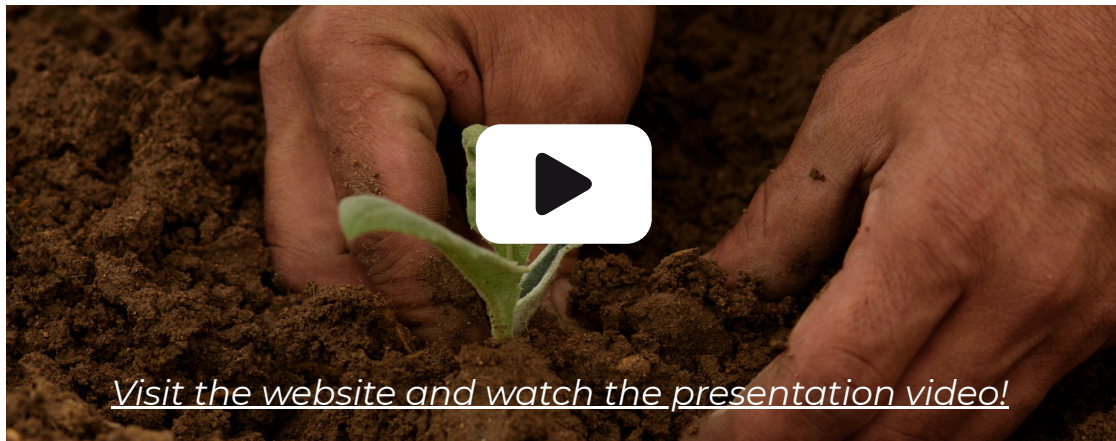
Creating recommendations to translate knowledge into practice.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS SO FAR

As the project progresses, here's a quick look at what we've achieved so far:



Laying the Foundations

We've analysed the latest scientific knowledge and on-the-ground experiences related to carbon farming in the Mediterranean. This work is helping us better understand its business potential and the broader environmental and social co-benefits it brings.



Piloting in the Field

Pilot farms in Italy and Catalonia, Spain are testing regenerative agricultural practices in real-world conditions. These pilots are generating essential data for modelling soil carbon dynamics and improving how we monitor carbon stock changes over time.



Developing the Tools

We're creating a Mediterranean-specific Monitoring, Reporting & Verification (MRV) framework and developing an IT platform to calculate carbon removals—crucial steps toward building a transparent and credible carbon credit system based on regenerative practices.



Spreading Knowledge

Training modules and video content are being developed for the Euro-MED Academy as part of a comprehensive "Carbon Farming in the Mediterranean" learning programme—designed to support capacity-building and knowledge transfer across the region.



Engaging Stakeholders

We've started engaging with food industry stakeholders and agricultural practitioners to raise awareness of carbon farming and create connections that will support future uptake and long-term impact.
