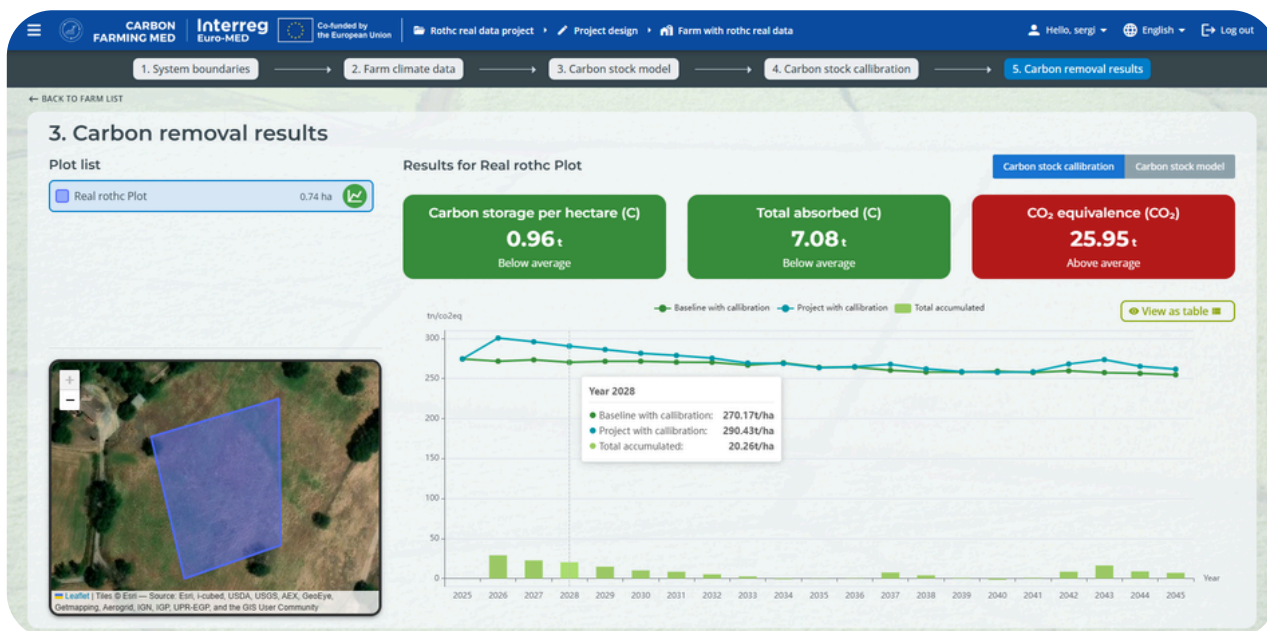
The Mediterranean MRV Platform Is Now Live

The Carbon Farming MED MRV Platform translates the project's technical outputs into a practical tool for end users. As the first MRV platform tailored to Mediterranean conditions, it helps farmers, cooperatives and project developers design, monitor and assess carbon farming projects.

The platform enables users to:

- ◆ Map plots and design projects
- ◆ Estimate carbon sequestration and GHG impacts
- ◆ Track progress against baseline scenarios
- ◆ Support certification and verification processes
- ◆ Explore funding and carbon market opportunities through an integrated marketplace
